Where will you be working?

As professor of translational brain tumour research, you will carry out scientific research on primary brain tumours within the CCA's Neuro-oncology Research Group (NRG), focusing on the following themes: 'Target Discovery & Preclinical Therapy Development', 'Clinical Therapy Development', 'Evaluation of Clinical Care and Quality of Life' and 'Imaging and Biomarkers'. The research will be accommodated within the Cancer Center Amsterdam research institute at Amsterdam UMC, location VUmc. You will also develop teaching material and teach Bachelor's and Master's students about brain tumours, focusing on primary brain tumours and current research lines in this field.

Work duties

The work duties consist of:

- Joint leadership of the Amsterdam Brain Tumour Centre clinic with the Professor of Preclinical Neuro-oncological Research, the Professor of Computational Biology (yet to be appointed) and the neurosurgeon responsible for the NRG;
- Devising, managing and implementing neuro-oncological care, research and teaching;
- Devising, managing and implementing cooperation in neuro-oncology in the region and on a national and international level;
- Contributing to fundraising;
- Obtaining academic patents and preparing academic publications, tests and therapies, achieving valorization where possible;
- Presenting results and promoting the Amsterdam Brain Tumour Centre's policy and vision in both academic and social domains;
- Contributing to the CCA/Amsterdam UMC policy and vision.

Profile

Candidates are expected to possess the following qualities:

- Excellent research skills, attested by a doctoral thesis, theses by supervised PhD students, high-quality academic publications and activities;
- Extensive and demonstrable expertise in brain tumour research and translational research;
- Experience in obtaining research grants;
- Experience in a managerial position;
- Good interpersonal and organizational skills;
- Knowledge of valorization opportunities for this specific research remit;
- Excellent academic teaching skills and experience.

Terms of employment

The gross monthly salary for a full-time contract is between €9,494 and €12,224 (Medical Professor Scale), depending on qualifications and experience.
